## MINUTES FORT BEND GRAND PARKWAY TOLL ROAD AUTHORITY

Director Condrey called the meeting to order.


## WORKSHOP ON POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR COLLECTION OF TOLL VIOLATIONS

Mr. Stone discussed current toll collection procedures in a Toll Collection Workshop presentation, a copy of which is attached. He noted that the current process in place accumulates high fees per violation and suggested an alternative method that would lower the amount of fees to the customer, and increase the collection rate. Mr. Muller reported the order of the collections process includes the processing center, collections from attorneys, and finally a court summons for the fees that go unpaid. Mr. Stone emphasized the main concern of MSA is lowering the total amount of fees accumulated for each customer.

Mr. Stone updated the Board on the violations processing transition from Conduent, formerly known as Xerox, to SWC. He reported on the Customer Service Initiative, and noted MSA is working to improve telephone customer service and changes to the Authority website are in progress.

Mr. Stone presented and reviewed a draft Toll Rate Order, and recommended the Board consider modifying the Toll Rate Order language regarding a rate increase on non-tag holders. Following review and discussion, the Board agreed to review this language at April's regular Board meeting.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
